Autism Crawley

Autism Crawley is a supportive group that meets once a month for a few hours in the evening and host a coffee morning each month, term time only. The aim of the group is to give parents and carers an opportunity to share information and advice, offer and receive informal support and have the chance to meet with other parents outside of the group. They cater for parents and carers of children or adults with autism or social communication difficulties, with or without a diagnosis.





BeyondAutism started as The Rainbow Charity in 2000, when a group of parents, led by Founder Karen Sorab, set up Rainbow School. We started with just 3 pupils in a rundown pre-fabricated hut on the grounds of Beatrix Potter School in Wandsworth.

Since then the charity has undergone a remarkable transformation, growing exponentially in response to need. We now deliver education to pupils from 16 London Local Authorities from our Early Years' service to our Post-19 Provision.



SENDIAS

At West Sussex SENDIAS, we provide impartial information, advice and support to children and young people who have SEND (special educational needs and/ or disabilities) for those aged 0-25 and their parent carers.



Reaching Families

Reaching Families is a parent-carer led, grassroots charity which aims to support parents and families of children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) in their daily lives, in particular through the delivery of information, training and peer support. We work with over 3,000 West Sussex families every year through a range of high quality projects and services.
